EIGNER HAUS

oldest house in Gablitz (16th / 17th century)

Location: Bachgasse 5, 3003 Gablitz

Named after its former owner, the "Eigner Haus" (= Eigner House) is the oldest house in Gablitz. The right part of the house, which is the oldest, dates back to the $16^{th}/17^{th}$ century. In all likelihood it used to be the ice cellar of the "Stiftstaffern", i.e. the monastery tavern, which was built by the Mauerbach Charterhouse in 1648.

The former "Kellerhäusl" (= cellar house), as it was known then, was expanded and improved in the 18th century. The house has been listed as a historic monument and is currently inhabited, which is why it can only be visited from the outside. Occasionally, however, the current tenants will organise exhibitions and music performances.
